

Count Philippe d'Espand having been warned that his massacre of the Huguenots was to take place on the 24th August, 1572, he left title and estates, chartered ships at his own expense and brought as many as would come with him to England. He was received with honours by Queen Elizabeth and remained at her court for some time. Queen Elizabeth appointed him Royal Commissioner of Woods in England where he bought large tracts of land in Queen's County and in the south-west of Ireland for which it is stated, he paid a fair price. It has been handed down through the family that Philippe d'Espand was a kinsman of Henry of Navarre and D of France. There is no record of his wife and family until his grandson, William:
